MAHAFFEY CAMP LADIES' SPRING CHARITY TEA

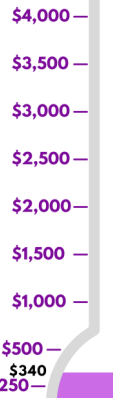
