LEAP OF FAITH

Our team is grateful for those who have been praying for many months, and even years, for us to find a more permanent place to worship each week. We started this church plant—Freedom Life Church—in Sendai, Japan, just as COVID 19 hit in the beginning of 2020. As a result, we worshiped on Zoom and then in the home of Stephen and Yire Woerner, Alliance international workers, for two years. In February 2022, we finally found a room to rent in a building. At the time, it was a great space with room to grow—the only real downside was that it had no heat or air conditioning and no place to store equipment. But we were so thankful for a place to worship publicly.

Last summer, we realized the lack of air conditioning was dangerous, and we were soon outgrowing the current space we have been using. With an average of 35 people each Sunday—about half of which are kids—we need additional space and more rooms for the children.

After we spent years looking for a long-term rental space or an affordable

place to buy, the Lord opened a location and has led the Japan Alliance mission to purchase two properties across from each other. One property has a big house on it that we plan to renovate to use as our church worship space and for Envision ministry, housing for visiting teams and interns, and possibly marketplace ministries. The smaller lot across the street will be used for parking, as street parking is not allowed. We look forward to how God will use the tools He's given us to expand His Kingdom here in Japan and beyond!

While this is a huge leap of faith, God very clearly opened the door for us to buy these separate properties that suddenly "happened" to go up for sale at the same time and for a great price. After making a down payment, we are trusting the Lord for the remaining funds by the end of April. We are thankful for the peace we have been given and are trusting God to miraculously provide even for this need. Please join us in praying!

LATIN AMERICAN YOUTH MINISTRY IS THRIVING

Praise God for the many doors He opened for Inca Link Costa Rica this past year! Operating in the capital city of San José, we seek to build partnerships with local churches, help them reach the next generation through various youth programs, form relationships in the community, and develop national leaders to take on ministry roles.

In one community, we were able to enter a public school with more than 600 students and do several remodeling projects in the school facilities. We also had the opportunity to teach three Bible classes and share the gospel with over 200 children. God enabled us to have our first teen camp last year at the church of Tres Ríos. We started this camp with no funds, and the Lord provided everything we needed. So many teams came to work with us during the year while sharing God's love with hundreds of kids—we even ran a VBS in a public school!
